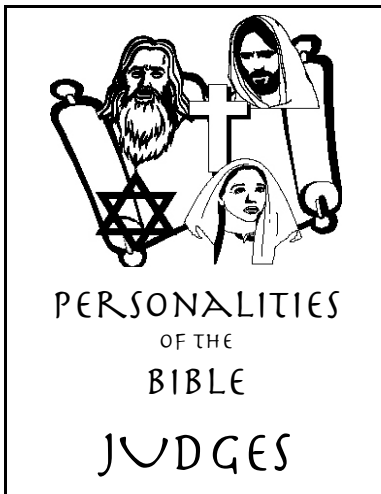

## *APPLICATIONS FROM LESSON 2*

### **HOW TO PUT GOD FIRST IN YOUR LIFE**

1. **DELIGHT IN HIM** by daily spending time with Him reading scripture and praying.  
Joshua 1:8, Romans 12:2, 1 Thess. 5:17, Psalm 37:2

Pray and ask God to make it joyful to read the scriptures. The payback for us is that we will succeed in whatever we do, be able to discern God's will for our life, and be protected from Satan's fiery darts. The whole spiritual armor is the word of God and being in constant prayer.

2. **HONOR GOD WITH YOUR BODY** by avoiding smoking, immorality, overeating, drugs, alcohol, bulimia, profanity, tattoo piercings and many other ungodly acts.

3. **HONOR GOD WITH YOUR FINANCES** by using money as a tool to be used as God directs. Do you view money as a tool or do you view it as a means to impress people or to have a wonderful retirement, etc.? The love of money is the root of all evil.
4. **HONOR GOD BY SEEKING TO BE A SERVANT**-We should ask God when we meet someone, do they have a need you want me to meet?
