

APPLICATIONS FROM LESSON 3

BONDS THAT HOLD ISRAEL TOGETHER

- 1. They all worship the same GOD (Deut. 6:4-7)
- 2. They are all related to the Patriarchs Abraham, Isaac & Jacob (Deut 6:10)
- 3. They saw and experienced the same miracles of God through 70 years of ministry of Moses and Joshua.
- 4. They lived in the same places at the same time (Canaan-Egypt-Canaan)
- 5. They had the same Laws (10 Commandments spoke by God and 613 Laws (Leviticus).
- 6. They had the same Levitical priesthood and The Tabernacle.
- 7. All the men were required to journey three time a year to worship at The Tabernacle.
- 8. They spoke the same language—Hebrew.
- 9. They are all related to each other (all cousins)
- 10. They are all part of the Abrahamic Covenant (Gen 17:7)
- 11. God has given them the same plan and purpose. All families of the earth will be blessed (Gen 12:3)
 - A. Produced the Messiah
 - B. Wrote the Bible
 - C. The teaching tool to the world about the true and living God. (Zech 9:20-23) Application for #11: Every Christian today has a job description of being God's teaching tool to an unsaved world (1 Peter 2:9)
- 12. They also had the same command from God "destroy the Canaanites". God gave the Canaanites many years to repent and turn to Him.
