

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APPLICATIONS FROM LESSON 25

REOPENING THE BLESSINGS OF GOD IN REGARDS TO MARRIAGE

- 1. If you have divorced a spouse confess this as a sin against God. God always blesses a repentant spirit. (1 John 1:9)
- 2. Ask forgiveness to those devastated by your actions. This will prevent bitterness from taking root in them causing ongoing problems. (James 4:6,10)
- 3. Never encourage anyone to divorce their spouse. (Malachi 2:16)
- 4. Understand that every marriage is a lifelong commitment and teach your children this truth. (1 Corinthians 7:39).
- 5. Following these steps will begin the process of restoring the years the locust has eaten (Joel 2:25).

CHOOSE GOD'S GRACE INSTEAD OF BITTERNESS

You choose God's grace:

- 1. By understanding who you are in Christ (Matthew 12:46-50)
- 2. By mediating upon God's unconditional love for you. (Romans 8:38-39) (Romans 5:8)
- 3. By choosing to forgive because God has forgiven you. (Romans 8:1)
