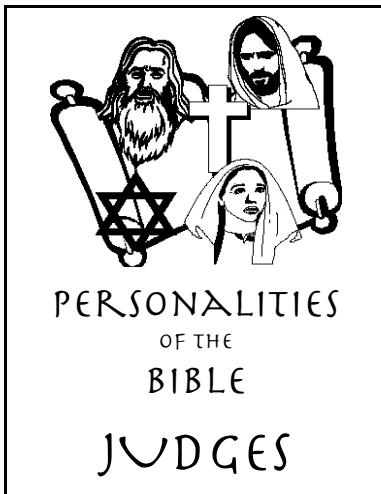

Applications- The Abrahamic Covenant

1. God's dealings with nations and individuals are always according to the treatment of the Jews.
2. God will always protect Israel because of The Abrahamic Covenant.
3. All Jewish people alive today are part of The Abrahamic Covenant.
4. The provisions of The Abrahamic Covenant have nothing to do with salvation.
5. Examine your own attitude toward the Jews or Israel. If you secretly hate Jews you are forcing God to hate you. Pray and ask for forgiveness and ask God to give you a heart for the Jews.
6. Do not participate in any organization that curses Jews or Israel.

A Christian is a Jew or Gentile who has a personal relationship with God through Jesus
