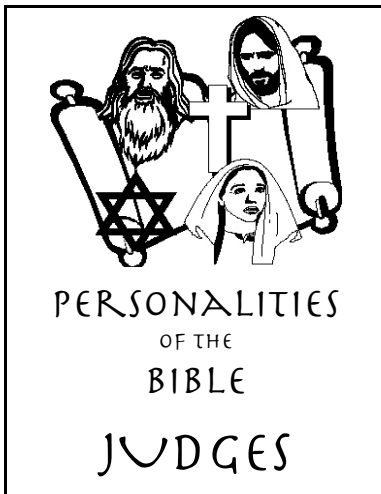

## ***APPLICATIONS FROM LESSON 36***

### **APPLICATION-GOD BLESSES US BECAUSE HE LOVES US**

God blesses us not because of our goodness but because of His character. It's all about Him.

### **APPLICATION- BEFORE MAKING AN IMPORTANT DECISION**

1. When you are afraid, put your trust in God. (Psalm 56:3-4) Your victory is all about God's goodness, power and control, not yours.
2. Always pray for wisdom and discernment for Godly choices. Ask God to prevent you from being deceived. Daily renewing your mind is critical in this process. Prayer without the word is deception. (Romans 12:2), (Joshua 1:8)
3. Wait upon the Lord. (Psalm 25:3) The Holy Spirit will give you the peace to proceed. If no peace, take no action! (Phil 4:6-7)
4. Remember God never rushes and he's never late. (Psalm 40:1-3)

### **APPLICATION—OUR MOUTH**

1. The less we talk the better.
2. The more we talk the more we sin. (Proverbs 29:20)
3. Be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger. (James 1:19)
4. When we are speaking to others, God will not be speaking with us. Cherish times of silence. (1 Samuel 3:9)
