

Lesson 15: Pharaoh was furious at Moses' request to allow Israel to leave for 3 days in order to sacrifice to the Lord. Consequently, Pharaoh increased the burden upon the Jewish people. The Jewish formen appealed directly to Pharaoh for mercy. Instead of mercy they were accused of laziness and ordered back to work.
