

LESSON 56: Moses' parents were spiritual giants. Despite Pharaoh's order that all Hebrew baby boy's be killed, Jochebed and Amram hid Moses for three months. Eventually Moses became the son of of Pharaoh's daughter. . Scripture also tells us that Moses became a man of power in word and deed. In fact, he correctly discerned that he would be God's instrument to free the Jews from 430 years of bondage. Moses thought that he could pick the time and method of this deliverance. His actions resulted in murder, rejection by the Jews and fleeing from Pharaoh and Egypt to live in Midian. For 40 long years Moses shepherded his father-in-laws flocks. Then and only then was he ready to do the work that God had appointed to him. Eighty year old Moses was less than thrilled to hear God's call. In fact, despite supernatural signs and wonders, Moses begged God to find someone else to do this work. Throughout the next year, God lovingly and patiently trained Moses. Moses became God's voice to Pharaoh announcing the 10 horrible plagues of judgment. After the death of the first born, Pharaoh let Moses and the 2 1/2 million Israelites leave Egypt. With them was the wealth of Egypt. God was teaching Moses and every Israelite, as well, that He was the Faithful, True, All-Powerful God who was completely Trustworthy. God met all of their needs, usually in Supernatural ways. He parted The Red Sea so Israel could walk along dry ground and escape from the Egyptian Army. As soon as the last Jewish foot crossed The Sea, the waters returned drowning Pharaoh and his Army. God supplied water in the desert, food, protection and guidance in the pillar of cloud by day and fire by night. It took Israel three months to reach Mt. Sinai. God summoned
